Parade Details and Route

- The Parade is on Saturday, May 10 2025.
- You will receive your parade route placement prior to the parade. Please park at the Community Center and walk to the Town Hall.
- Participants will meet at the Malta Town Hall located at 2540 Rt 9 at 9:00 am. Assembly begins at 9:30 in the Court and Town Hall Parking lots. Parade starts at 10:05 am.
- The Parade route will begin on Route 9 going south through the roundabout and travel north to end at the Community Center at 1 Bayberry Drive.

Parade Rules

- 1. The Parade Chairpersons/Marshals will be in charge and reserve the right to dismiss any entrant who does not abide by parade rules. The parade Chairpersons/Marshals have the right to accept, reject, reclassify or remove any unit.
- 2. No material may be thrown, discarded or sprayed by or from any entry
- 3. Entries having children must provide parents or other adult chaperones to supervise.
- 4. All living things on a moving entry must be secured. No one is allowed to ride on a running board, hood, roof or vehicle fender.
- 5. Units having animals must maintain control of them at all times.
- 6. No firearms shall be fired and no open flames allowed. All floats shall have a 2A-10BC rated fire extinguisher on board for safety reasons
- 7. No political slogans or materials shall be displayed or distributed.
- 8. Entries must start at appointed start place and complete entire parade route.
- 9. The Committee reserve the right to revise the placement of all entries
